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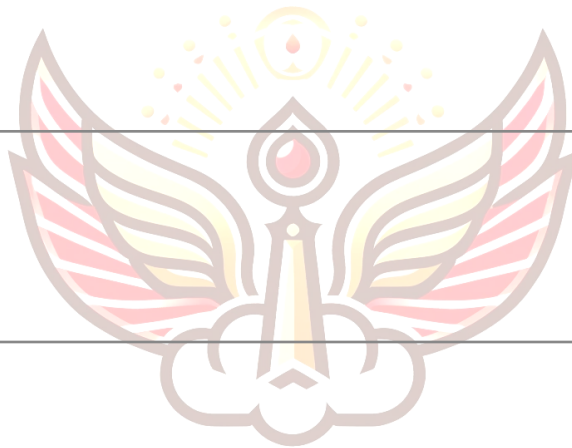
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Bloodlines of Babylon: Genesis

As the centuries passed, the vampires continued to grapple with their curse. Some sought redemption, while others embraced their dark nature.

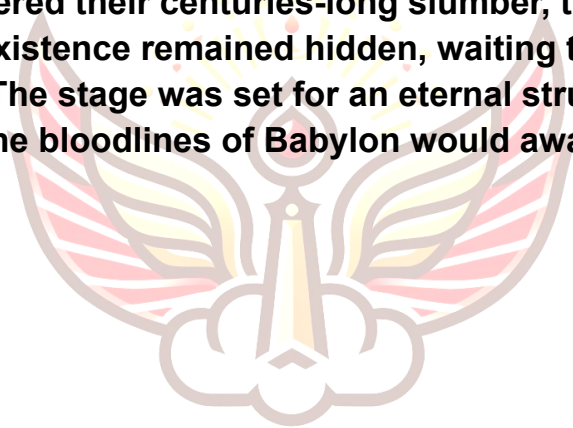
The cult remained united in their secrecy, but divided in their visions for the future...
